

## Before your Trip

# Find out what kind of visa you need, apply in time

Where are you coming from? Are you only going sailing with us or are you planning a longer trip in the country? Are you entering and exiting Myanmar from the same (air)port? These are all important questions for finding out what kind of permissions and visas you need. We are happy to assist during the visa application process or help you organise a visa on arrival. You will need to bring a couple of passport photos in that case. Please tell us about your plans and let us know if you have any questions.



## Consult your doctor. Get vaccinations if necessary

The medical system in Myanmar is still far from meeting international standards. Consult your doctor about possible risks, such as tropical diseases. And please tell us about any medical conditions we should be aware of.



#### Do you have sufficient insurance?

Some health insurances policies exclude trips to certain countries. Others do not cover water sports like sailing. Make sure you have sufficient coverage for your trip.



### Need a lift?

#### Book hotels and flights in time

Myanmar's tourism industry is not keeping up with the fast-growing demand and hotels and flights can be difficult to book. If you are planning a longer trip in the country, make sure to book in time. #### Bring enough cash

In most parts of Myanmar it's still impossible to find ATMs and credit cards are rarely accepted. Make sure you bring enough foreign currency. In the Mergui, US-Dollars and Thai Baht work best.



### Don't forget there's a time difference

There's a 30 minute (yes, really, 30 minutes) time difference from Thailand - many people forget that.



#### If possible, bring soft bags
